Archery Combat Rules

Must be 8 years old to play.

Players must wear protective mask at all times.

Diamond archery will provide bows, arrows and masks. You can wear your own mask.

Players must sign a waiver form before participating.

Spectators must stand back at least 10 yards from playing field.

The game cannot start and must stop if a Diamond Archery employee is not present and supervising the game.

Game will start with as few as 1 player on each side and a max of 7 players on each side.

Arrows will be in the center of the safety zone

When the judge signals start, players can grab arrows and begin combat.

The objective is to nock all three of your opponent's balls off their cone.

Players cannot be shot in the safety zone. If a player shoots another player while they are in the safety zone the shooter is out.

Player is out if he or any of his equipment is hit. He will be replaced with the next player in line.

Players may leave the playing box to retrieve arrows but, must leave his bow in the playing box. If a player steps out of the playing box with a bow in his hand he is out.

If a player catches an arrow before it touches the ground, the shooter of that arrow is out.

There is a 7 minute time period on each game, with one minute the ref will call last minute and at this point no one will come back in the game only leave if they get shot or someone catches their arrow. At the end of the 7 minutes the team with the most balls and players wins and starts the next game. The loosing team will be replaced with all new players. If it is a tie, put the balls on the cones and start a new game with players on the field and new players from the line to fill both teams up to 7 again.

Game is over at the end of the 7 minutes
